Mountina

Valcom offers three backboxes (not included) for mounting the VIP-412A-DF-IC speaker. The VB-R19 (recess mount); VB-S20 (surface mount) and VB-A21(angled surface mount) are all designed to fit the VIP-412A-DF-IC. Mount the backbox according to the instructions provided with the backbox. After mounting the backbox, connect the Ethernet cable to the RJ-45 jack on the speaker. Mount the speaker baffle to the backbox with the hardware provided.

Assembly and Mounting

The VIP-412A-DF-IC is designed for recessed or flush mounting to a Valcom backbox (not included). For recessed mounting, the Valcom VB-R19 may be used. For surface mounting, use the Valcom VB-S20 or VB-A21.

If not using a Valcom backbox, use the dimensions shown in Figure 2 as a guide to cut a hole in the mounting surface large enough to allow recessing the VIP-412A-DF-IC into the wall. Next, drill mounting holes in the surface to align with the four mounting holes in the grille. Using appropriate anchors and screws (not included), mount the VIP-412A-DF-IC to the surface.

Network Connection




Figure 1. Connections

The VIP-412A-DF-IC has one RJ-45 network connector on the rear panel. Use a standard patch cable to connect the VIP-412A-DF-IC to an Ethernet switch providing Power over Ethernet (PoE) meeting the 802.3af specification. If the switch does not provide power, a mid-span power injector may be used. (See Figure 1)

MUTE OUT CONNECTION



LED Connection

LED 1 (+) and LED 2 (-) is a current limited output designed to illuminate an optional LED. The LED is intended to provide visual indication of call progress. The LED illumination will flash when the call switch is pressed and will continue to flash until the call is answered. The LED illumination will be solid when a connection to the unit is established.

-10 dB Line Level Out Connection

The -10dBm Line Level Out may be connected to up to 40 Valcom Self Amplified Speakers in order to provide additional sound reinforcement in an area.

Setup


The VIP-412A-DF-IC will automatically acquire an IP address (using DHCP) and connect to the InformaCast server when connected to the network and powered up. Time synchronization is provided by the InformaCast server. Information specific to your application will need to be programmed into the InformaCast server. Refer to the InformaCast documentation for further information.
