VIP-412-DF IP ONE-WAY FLUSH MOUNT SPEAKER/CLOCK ASSEMBLY

INTRODUCTION

The VIP-412-DF One-Way IP Wall Speaker with Clock enables voice access and visual time indication to a single zone of one-way paging over an IP-based LAN/WAN. This allows page zone extension anywhere on the network. The speaker level is adjusted via software during set up. Clock synchronization is initiated via connection to any Network Time Protocol (NTP) server accessible via the network. The enclosure is made of steel with a durable gray powder coated finish. The color of the enclosure can easily be changed to match any decor. A detachable black clothe grille is included. Power is provided to the VIP-412-DF via a Power over Ethernet (PoE) switch meeting the 802.3af specification.

Mounting

The VIP-412-DF is designed for flush mounting on a hollow surface or to a Valcom backbox. Using the dimensions shown in Figure 2 as a guide, cut a hole in the mounting surface large enough to allow recessing the VIP-412-DF into the wall. Next, drill mounting holes in the surface to align with the four mounting holes in the grille. Using appropriate anchors and screws (not included), mount the VIP-412-DF to the surface. Alternatively, Valcom backbox model VB-R19 is available for mounting this model.

Network Connection




Figure 1. Connections

The VIP-412-DF has one RJ-45 network connector on the rear panel. Use a standard Ethernet patch cable and connect the VIP-412-DF to an Ethernet switch. (See Figure 1)

-10 dB Line Level Out Connection

The -10dBm Line Level Out may be connected to up to 40 Valcom Self Amplified Speakers in order to provide additional sound reinforcement in an area.

Setup

Information specific to your application will need to be programmed into the VIP-412-DF using a computer. The PC used for programming should be connected to the same subnet as the VIP-412-DF. Setup will be done using the IP

Solutions Setup Tool. The IP Solutions Setup Tool may be downloaded from the Valcom website at www.valcom.com/vipsetuptool.




Figure 2. Mounting Dimensions
