

VMT-1 INPUT MATCHING TRANSFORMER

CONNECTIONS

The VMT-1 provides an impedance match between a 500-600 Ohm balanced line and a high impedance auxiliary or microphone input of an amplifier.

The VMT-1 may also be used to attenuate the audio output of a 25-volt amplifier to a level suitable to connect to a line level input.

Connections to the HI Z I/O of the VMT-1 may be made via standard phono patch cable or via screw terminals.

Connections to the 600-Ohm I/O of the VMT-1 may be made via screw terminals.

DIMENSIONS/WEIGHT

- 1.75" H x 3.75" W x 1.25" D (4.45cm H x 9.53cm W x 3.2cm D)

Figure 1: Shows the VMT-1 being used to connect a 600-Ohm balanced line output to the auxiliary input of a commercial amplifier. If the amplifier uses phono jacks for auxiliary input connections a patch cable with male phono ends may be used for the connection. Shielded single conductor wiring should be used when the amplifier is equipped with screw terminal connections.




FIGURE 1: Input Matching Transformer



Figure 2: To connect a 600-Ohm line output to a 1/4" microphone input of an amplifier, **move the shorting jumper to the upper 2 header pins** on the unit.






FIGURE 2: Connection to Microphone Input

Figure 3: In order to attenuate a 25-volt amplifier output to line level audio, connect the 25V speaker line common to HIZ SHLD screw terminal. Connect the other side of 25V line to the remaining HIZ out screw terminal. Line level audio will be available on the 600-Ohm I/O. Shorting jumper should be in normal position.





TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
